In an effort to promote a positive environment for youth soccer we ask you to read the expectations listed below, sign, and return to your team manager

BE SUPPORTIVE OF THE PLAYERS AND THE GAME

- Kids play better and enjoy the game more when the atmosphere from parents and fans is POSITIVE.
- Refrain from any negative comments towards the referees, other team's players, your team's players, coaches, and fans.
- Support, promote, and develop sportsmanship.

RECOGNIZE THE ROLES OF PARENT AND COACH, AND THAT THEY ARE SEPARATE

- Coaches are present to instruct, motivate, and teach your son/daughter to improve his/her ability to play the game. As a spectator we ask you to support your child regardless of performance.
- If you are upset with the coach please refrain from any contact about the issue until 24 hours have passed. Then, set up a meeting with the coach via phone, email, or direct contact AFTER PRACTICE.
- Do not approach a coach about an issue on game days or before training, as these are the busiest times for any coach.
- Your child may try many different positions in his/her career. This is to enhance his/her long-term development.
- There will be times when players are instructed to do things that parents do not understand, be aware that these instructions are intended to improve long-term development.
